# New Graphical User Interface

The Graphical User Interface is an OSF/Motif-style interface for HP 64700 Series emulators and analyzers that makes it easier for designers to learn and use HP emulation products. Features such as pull-down and pop-up menus, point and click breakpointing, cut and paste, on-line help, and user customizations including action keys and pop-up recall buffers take users to a new level of productivity. New users come up to speed quickly, and users of our previous generation emulation interface can continue to use the commands they already know -- or move even faster by using the new graphical features.

---

### Softkey Interface for ASCII Terminals Included

Both the Graphical User Interface and the Softkey Interface are part of the HP 9000 hosted interface product. If you are running the X Window System, the Graphical User Interface is the default interface. If the X Window System is not running, the Softkey Interface is the default interface.

When you are running the X Window System, **emul700** command line options (**emul700 -u skemul < 64700\_name>** ) allow you to start up the Softkey Interface instead of the Graphical User Interface.

### Documentation: Graphical User Interface vs. Softkey Interface

There are manuals for the Softkey Interface and a manual for the Graphical User Interface. The *Graphical User Interface* manual describes how to use the interface and does not contain information about a particular emulator. The

Softkey Interface manuals contain emulator specific information as well as descriptions of how to use the Softkey Interface.
