Pages 215 to 298 of this issue are the Proceedings of the conference on The Physics of Semimetals which was held in Pupin Laboratory, Columbia University, on January 21, 1964. It was a Topical Conference of the American Physical Society, and served to bring together many of the people, recently increasing in number, active in research on the subject or otherwise interested in it.
