OS Data Processing with Review of OS/VS, H. Carroll (SDD Poughkeepsie), John Wiley & Sons, Inc., New York, 1974.

OS Data Processing describes the levels of hardware and software, and the relationships among them, which make up a modern computer system. Using sample programs, mainly in the COBOL language, the text explores operating systems processing through examples and their interpretation. The examples are used to demonstrate what the system does and what the user does, such understanding being viewed as basic to efficient and effective programming. Topics include the historical development of data processing; COBOL, Assembler, Link Editor, and

Execution; OS/360 task management and IOS; OS/VS: OS job management and processing; data management; telecommunications processing; and miscellaneous topics such as SYSGEN, IPL and DOS systems.

Simulación en la Empresa (Simulation Technique in Business), L. F. Escudero (IBM Spain, Madrid Scientific Center) Ediciones Deusto, Bilbao, Spain, 1973.

This book explores the use of simulation in business problems involving queuing processes. Part one describes and compares

methods of generating random numbers and details the basis and operational procedure of Monte Carlo simulation, using numerical examples with normal, Poisson, exponential, hyper-exponential, beta, and uniform probability distributions. The principal characteristics of some widely used simulation codes are described in part two along with numerical applications to illustrate important blocks of the programs. In the final section simulation is applied to actual business cases involving different queuing phenomena, inventory control, project control, and production scheduling. Control programs and interpretation of results are provided for each case.
