## Using the Index

The 1962–1994 Cumulative Index consists of three parts. The Author Index lists all authors and includes complete titles of all published papers. The Subject Index categorizes each paper according to one or more topical areas. The Abstracts section contains abstracts of all papers by volume number and issue.

Complete issues and reprints of individual papers generally may be ordered up to three years after publication. See the inside front cover of this index for more information on how to order.

Author Index. Entries in the Author Index are arranged alphabetically by author. If a paper has multiple authors, the entry for the author whose name appears first on the paper contains the title of the paper and all other authors. The other authors are also listed as individual entries.

Following is a sample of two entries from the Author Index. The first of these lists the names of the authors, the title in italics, volume (boldface), issue, beginning page number, and year of publication. If reprints are still available, an order number is provided in italics as the last item. The second entry shows a listing of one of the multiple authors from the same paper.

Subject Index. Entries in the Subject Index list the title of a paper, followed by the last name of the author. For papers that have multiple authors, the name given is that of the author whose name appears first on the paper. The next items listed are the volume (boldface), issue, beginning page number, and year of publication.

Abstracts. The Abstracts section lists papers chronologically by volume, issue, and year, in the order in which they appear in the table of contents of each issue. If an issue is still available, an order

number is provided in italics. Individual entries show the title (boldface), authors, and beginning page number of each paper, followed by the abstract. [[Page 538 is blank]]
