Antigen can also scan incoming and outgoing SMTP mail messages at Microsoft Exchange's Internet Mail Service (IMS) connector of Exchange 5.5 or the SMTP transport stack of Exchange 2000, in addition to the mailbox server. With trusted scanning, messages scanned at the IMS Antigen Active X control. server are not re-scanned by Antigen at the mailbox server. By distributing the scanning across servers, Antigen exceeds administrators' expectations for protection and server efficiency.

To avoid taxing resources and enhance scanning performance, mail attachments are scanned in memory instead of spooling files to disk. Antigen also uses network resources efficiently by the single scanning of a file that is to be transmitted to multiple recipients.

Remote administration —

Antigen is enterprise-ready and can be installed easily from a single location to all Exchange servers — including Exchange 2000. In addition, you can configure and monitor all Antigen


