Recent benchmarks using the NotesBench standard have demonstrated the power of the Compaq *ProLiant* 8500 server by supporting 16,000 benchmark users — the highest number of users ever supported on any Windows platform.

This 8-way server is based on the Profusion architecture, which was co-developed by Compaq and Intel, and the Pentium III Xeon processor. It supports one to eight 700-MHz Intel Pentium III processors with a 100-MHz front-side bus, full-speed cache, and 100-MHz 2-way interleaved SDRAM DIMM memory that is expandable to 8 GB (16 GB in the future). The Compaq *ProLiant* 8500 server is the only solution platform used by Lotus to test and validate Domino R5.0.7 for Windows 2000 Advanced Server and Datacenter Server.

Compaq *ProLiant* DL360 server — performance and availability in an ultra-thin 1U chassis

Based on audited NotesBench results, the *ProLiant* DL360 server has demonstrated its ability to support up to 5,800 benchmark users in a single-processor configuration. In further testing with two CPUs, the system supported up to 9,500 users. This server is ideal for businesses with limited data center space.
